Keeping Eastwood Secure

STOP — LOOK — LISTEN

Neighbors, please take a few minutes of your daily routine and do the following in our Eastwood boundaries:

Stop — Actually stop and pay attention if you think something in our area is not normal, or seems suspicious. People are not normally suspicious, but, their behavior is. An example would be someone walking between houses and checking doors and windows.

Look — If you see something or someone doing what is not "normal" and seems suspicious to you observe from where you are and then take the appropriate action, which might be calling 911 and reporting what you are seeing to the 911 Operator and let the Dallas Police check it out.

Something you could do on your own would be if you see papers piling up in your neighbor's yard, trashcans out of place, or other things that are not normal, call them or knock on their door and determine if all is okay. Put the papers out of sight and put the cans back where you normally see them. They could be out of the city or ill.

Listen — When driving or walking in our area, pay attention to what you hear and consider what you are hearing; is it a normal sound or something abnormal and suspicious. Breaking glass, or loud crashing noises, could be an indication of a break in. Do not challenge anyone. Instead call 911 and let the police check it out.

An example would be hearing breaking glass. It could be someone breaking into a neighbor's home or car and stealing property. Or worse, someone might be home and they could be in danger. Take action and call 911 and give the operator what you have heard and the location as best you can.

Neighbors taking these three steps on a daily basis will help all of us to be safer and more assured of our peace and comfort in our beautiful Eastwood boundaries.

VOLUNTEERS IN PATROL (VIP)

The VIP program consists of volunteers who patrol their neighborhood and alert police to possible law breaking. Many burglaries and other crimes have been interrupted. VIPs work with residents to make their homes more secure and remind them when pets have escaped, delivered packages are visible, or doors, gates and garage doors have been left open.



Join our VIP program. We need you to continue our 3 patrols daily of the neighborhood. Other than the ability to pass a background check by the Dallas Police Department, all that is required to be a VIP is to attend six hours of training.
